I had high 5's words of encouragement, people calling my name out and offers of jelly babies (which were gratefully accepted). Words cannot describe the enormous high you are on throughout the run and it is so easy to get carried away and burn yourself out after before the finish, I did see many runners along the route in a distressed condition being cared for by the St Johns ambulance brigade.

The highlight for me was approaching Tower Bridge as I found my family and friends for the first time, no time to stop just gave them all high 5's and I was on my way. No sooner had I passed them when Tower Bridge came into sight. The noise from the crowd is awesome it's something I will always remember and cherish.'

David says,

'We became aware of Silver Star through the support you gave to my brother-in-law's wife, Sharon Northwood, who went through a difficult pregnancy with the loss of her first child, Jonathon, who was Stillborn. Since then she has had two further pregnancies with the help, support and expertise of Silver Star, whose team and nurses gave excellent care with "nothing being too much trouble". She had several hospital admissions with severe sickness and says at all times she was treated like a first class patient. In her own words "I cannot thank Silver Star enough for all they have done for me and my family, we now have two beautiful boys, Joshua 4, and Joseph 2, who we know would not be here with us if Silver Star Society did not exist".'



It would be terrible if the care you offer was not available to other expectant mothers having difficulties and the more that can benefit from it the better, so we are very pleased to be able to support your charity.'

# Abseil down the JR

On March 28th 42 people abseiled down the walls of the John Radcliffe Hospital in aid of Silver Star. The participants were linked to us in various ways, but their goal was the same, to raise as much money for our wonderful Unit as possible. The day itself was dry and fairly sunny. There was a marvellous atmosphere and camaraderie amongst those who were doing the Abseil. It was a great challenge for some, but everyone who went up did come down safely!

We would like to thank GA Electrical from Wallingford who supplied us with 17 participants, they raised £3752 from sponsors plus £700 in Gift Aid which is truly magnificent. It was Glen Dearlove's (GA Electrical, Small Works Manager) idea to support this event as his wife Becky recently celebrated the birth of their baby daughter Isabelle who was born at 33 weeks weighing 2lbs 9ozs. The birth came after Becky had spent 7 weeks under the care of the Silver Star Unit being monitored daily. After Isabelle was born she was taken to the Special Care Unit and due to the way the Silver Star Unit is funded, both Glenn and Becky were able to stay together at the hospital for the following 5 days, meaning Becky could recover and they could both be close to Isabelle. Isabelle went home just 4 weeks later and is doing very well.

Placi was referred to Silver Star when she was pregnant because of a rare genetic blood condition that put her at very high risk of suffering from a blood clot or thrombosis during and after the pregnancy.

Silver Star gave Placi the courage and confidence to know that while she was at a high risk while expecting her son she was definitely under the care and supervision of the best professionals at the JR Hospital.

Most women enjoy being pregnant and look forward to the baby months; Placi was able to do this because she knew she was in the safest hands she could be. Tests were done as often as needed and having someone as caring, warm, knowledgeable and charismatic as Prof Redman helped her understand and be prepared for anything that could happen.

Conor was a very healthy baby when he was born on 28th July 2005 and Placi managed to have a natural birth and enjoyed being a mum as she still does, knowing that without Silver Star it could have been a very different dangerous and risky process.

During the last few years Placi has managed to get more and more involved in fundraising for Silver Star, helping Maggie raise its profile and trying to get more local organisations involved with the Society and she is delighted that she will be able to bring her personal experience from being a Silver Star Mum in to the new role she has taken on.

Placi works full time as Senior Business Advisor for businesses in Oxfordshire that are looking at commercialising new innovative ideas into market and is hoping to bring her skills in marketing, fundraising and public speaking to help Silver Star from now on.

## Research Update. Developing New Predictive Test for Pre-eclampsia

Hazel Meacher, Senior Research Midwife, writes, 'As part of the Oxford Safer Pregnancy Alliance our Pregnancy Biobank is collecting blood, urine and ultrasound scan measurements from pregnant women who would like to participate. Our aim is to find better ways of predicting pre-eclampsia so that better care and resources can be focused on those who most need it. We look for factors in the mother's blood, the levels of which change before she becomes ill. We have been working with a company who are using some of our Biobank samples to develop a new predictive test for pre-eclampsia – the Triage® Placental Growth Factor Test. This is still in the very early stages but ultimately would help pregnant women by providing a blood test that can be carried out in clinic – in just 15 minutes.'



As many of you know we work very closely with the Silver Star Society, who have helped us in our research and have already committed over £100,000 to support some of the OSPREA projects.

At a recent Research Public Open Day in the main hospital, Professor Christopher Redman and myself gave a Café presentation on OSPREA and the Biobank. Many thanks to the wonderful Silver Star Mums and their families who gave their photos for me to use in my part of the presentation.'
