

Terms and conditions for sellers

General principles

- A table is approx. 6ft x 2ft
- No items can be displayed on the floor, so if you would like to sell bigger items please consider a second table
- One responsible adult per table (if bringing children please ensure another adult present to supervise)
- Sellers will be invited to set up from 9am, and able to purchase items in the Earlybird sale from 9.45am
- The sale will begin at 10am and end promptly at 12pm
- The sellers are responsible for setting up and clearing up their table area
- Payments are by cash only (machines available on level 3 opposite entrance to postgraduate centre and by M&S at main entrance)
- All tables will deal with their payments independently so sellers to bring an appropriate float
- Silver Star Society does not take any responsibility for goods sold on the tabletop sales and is not responsible for any loss or damage to items at the venue
- All items should be clean

Clothes

- All items must be of very good quality (new or nearly new condition)
- We would advise that clothes are separated according to size +/- or type, and prices clearly labelled

Toys

- All toys must be of good quality, safe, and be accompanied by the product instructions / safety instructions when possible
- They should be in working order with no broken parts or sharp edges

Electrical items

- Anything that connects to mains electricity (has a plug) must be Portable Appliance Tested (PAT) by a qualified electrician (Silver Star Society do not endorse the testing or the product).

- If a toy is battery powered, please inspect battery compartment prior to sale to ensure no leakage. We suggest new batteries are inserted just prior to the sale (this will enable buyers to ensure that the toy is in full working order).

Equipment

- This should be clean and in good working order
- If selling a baby carrier/sling, please enclose the manufacturers instruction and attach the following disclaimer:

“This sling/carrier is second-hand and the purchaser should check the sling thoroughly and satisfy themselves that it is safe, before use. If this sling is being sold without the manufacturers’ instructions, we recommend you contact the manufacturer and obtain the correct instructions for this sling to ensure you are using it correctly and safely.”

Please do not sell:

- **Any items that have been recalled by the manufacturer** <http://www.tradingstandards.uk/advice/advice-recall-list.cfm>
- Bednest cribs (even with modification kit)
- Baby positioner pillows or anti-roll products
- Bag style baby slings
- Baby hammocks
- Food items including baby food and formula milk
- Used bottles, baby bottle propping devices / bottle holders
- Cot bumpers
- Car seats, booster seats or bases
- Safety helmets for riding or cycling
- Mattresses that are not waterproof, firm and flat
- ~~Second hand breast pumps~~
- Clothes secured by a cord through the material
- Bumbos that lack a safety strap
- Cosmetics that are opened, not originally for sale in the UK or beyond their use by date
